# Giant Star Quilt 

54" x 54"

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You will need:
Background fabric - 1 1/8 yd.
Color A-1 yd.
Color B - 1 yd.
Binding (opt.) - $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$.
Backing - $31 / 8$ yd. of $45^{\prime \prime}$ or
$13 / 4$ of wide backing fabric
Batting - approx. 62" square

## Directions

## Cutting

Background - cut four $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Background - cut four $127 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 127 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Color A - cut four $127 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 127 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Color B - cut four 12 7/8" x 12 7/8"
Borders (from either Color A or B) - cut 5
strips 3 1/2" wide.
Cornerstones (from either Color A or B) - cut
four 3 1/2" x 3 1/2".
Binding (opt.) - cut 6 strips 2 1/2" wide.

## Piecing

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $127 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $127 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Background fabric and Color A or B (whichever is
 lighter). Draw another line $1 / 4$ " on each side of the diagonal line. These will be your seam lines.
2. Layer two fabrics, right sides together: 2 with Background/Color A, 2 with Background/Color B and 2 with Color A/ Color B. Press.
3. Stitch on the seam lines; cut on the diagonal line. Press seams toward the dark fabric.
4. Stitch together the block as illustrated, first into 4 Four Patch blocks, then stitch the Four Patches together.


## Borders

5. Stitch all the border strips together to make one long strip. Measure the width through the middle of the quilt top. Cut 2 strips this length. Measure the length through the middle of the quilt top. Cut 2 strips this length.
6. Stitch a border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward the border. Stitch a cornerstone at each end of the remaining border strips. Press seams towards the border. Stitch remaining borders to the sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the border.

## Finishing

7. Piece or cut backing the same size as the quilt top. Right sides together, stitch backing and quilt top around all 4 sides, leaving an 8" opening to turn. Layer quilt on top of batting; stitch on the previous stitching. Trim batting even with quilt edges. Turn right side out. Hand stitch opening closed. To set the edge, stitch $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the outer edge. Tie quilt at the center and corners of each block.
Optional - Layer backing, batting and top. Quilt as desired and bind.
