

# Rosy Posy Rows

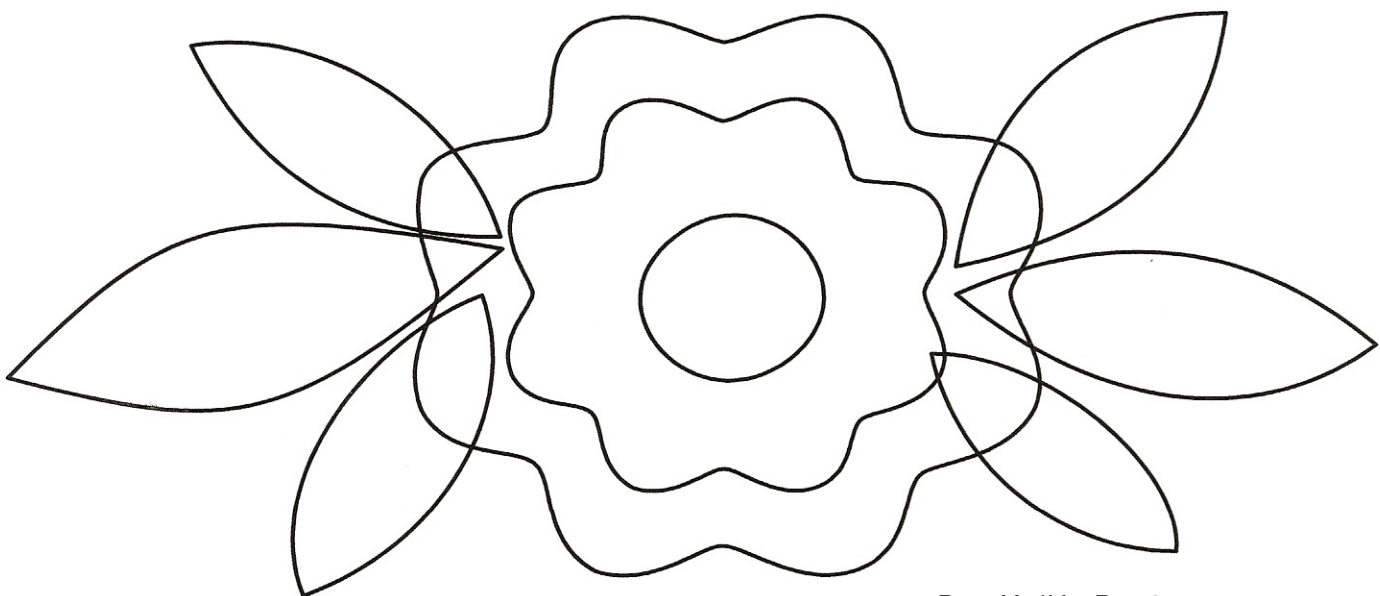
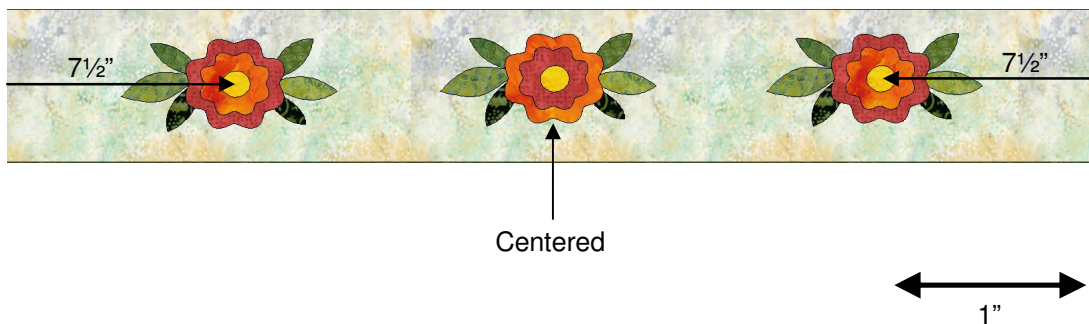
## Row 2

Appliqués shapes do not include seam allowances.

### Applique Directions:

Cut background  $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 36\frac{1}{2}''$ . With a pencil, trace appliqué shapes onto paper side of fusible web. Cut out the shapes, leaving about a  $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch margin around each piece. Place fusible web shapes paper side up (you don't want to fuse these to your iron!) on the wrong side of each corresponding appliqué fabric and fuse in place according to manufacturer's instructions. Allow to cool, cut out the shapes on the marked line and peel off paper backing.

Place shapes right side up onto the background; the center of the center circle of each of the two outer motifs is about  $7\frac{1}{2}''$  from the raw edge and the center motif is centered on the background. Fuse in place according to manufacturer's instructions. Cover edges of each appliqué shape with hand blanket stitch or machine zigzag, satin stitch or blanket stitch. Or you may want to hand appliqué in the traditional manner of your choice.
